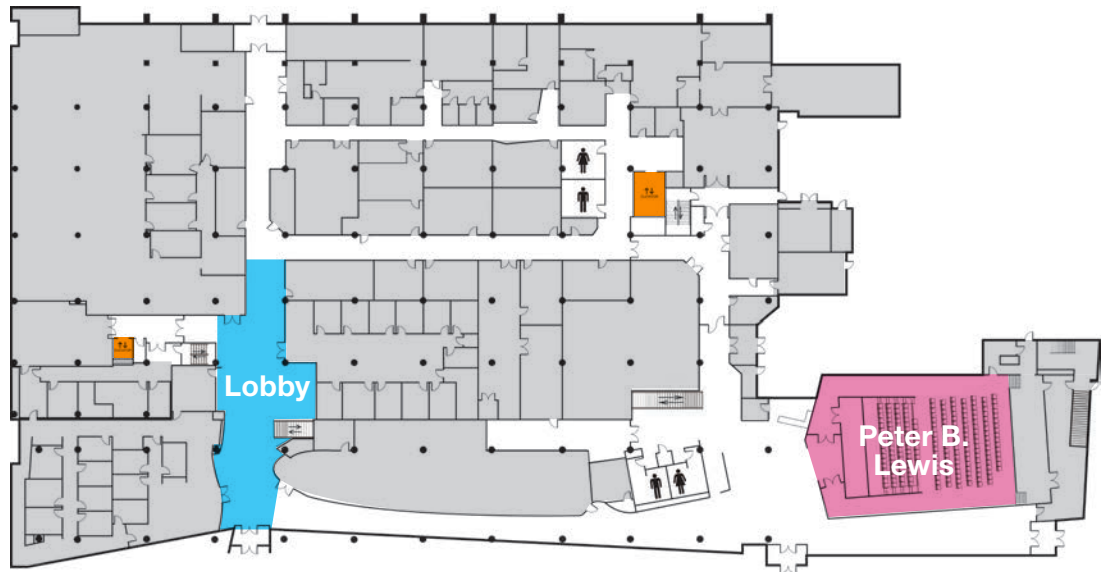
### William Harper: The Beautiful & the Grotesque

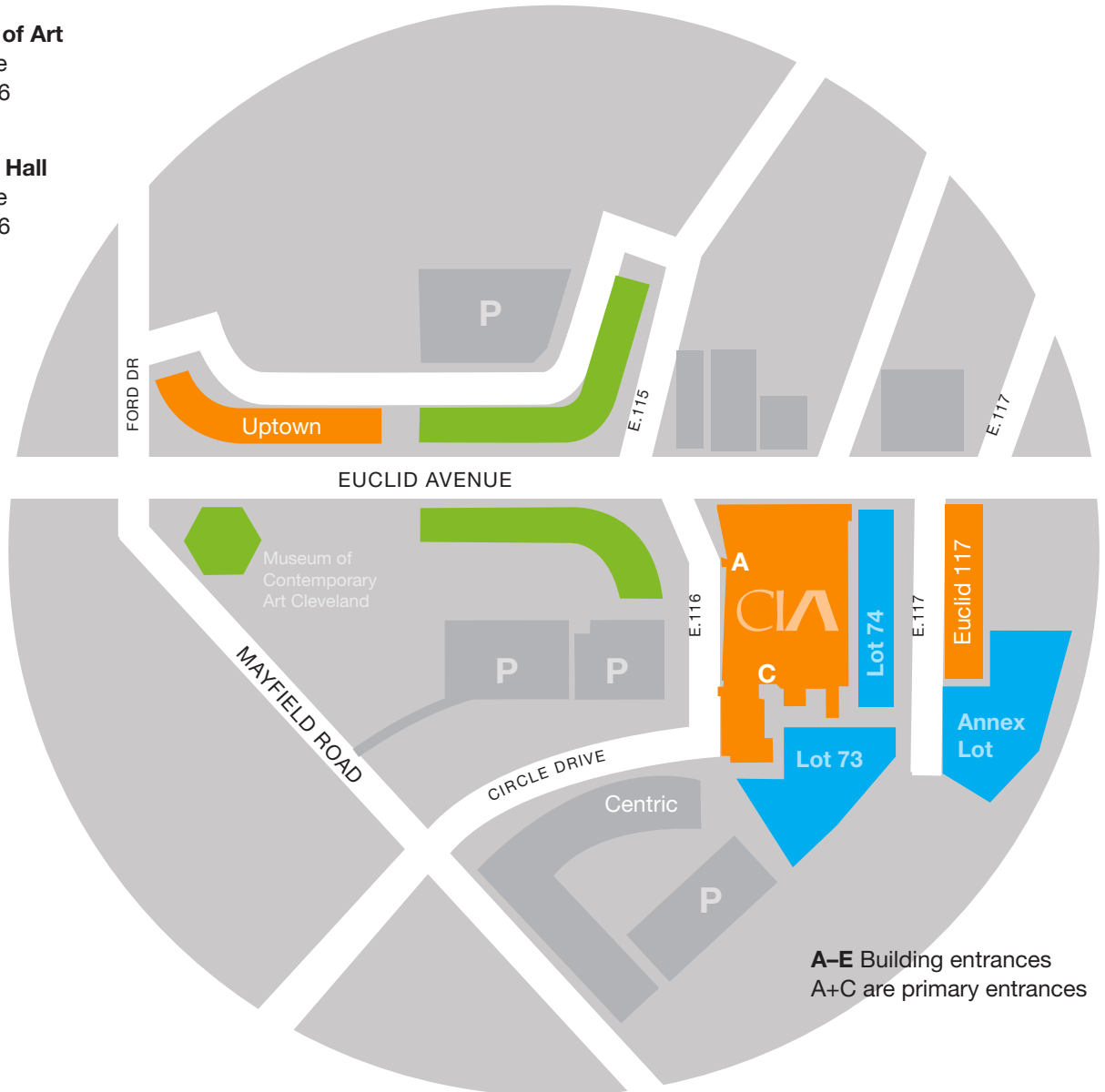

A B-17 bomber and its melting-pot crew confront Japanese forces in the immediate aftermath of Pearl Harbor. This rousing, exciting, moving WWII drama—Howard Hawks' contribution to the national war effort—boasts a strong cast (John Garfield, Arthur Kennedy, Gig Young, et al.) and dialogue by an uncredited William Faulkner. It's a superior example of flag-waving, "why we fight" propaganda, full of Hawks' favorite themes (loyalty, professionalism, camaraderie, group dynamics). Film preserved by Library of Congress. 124 min.
