
William Harper: The Beautiful & the Grotesque **Reinberger Gallery**

William Harper's lush objects combine unexpected materials and techniques, simultaneously evoking ancient cultures in a decidedly contemporary context.


Harper '67, is an artist whose works in metals and enamel are in museums across the globe, including the Vatican Museum and the Metropolitan Museum of Art.


